Generic Risk Assessment

- This is an Outdoor Learning programme. Groups will need to be briefed on environmental conditions and behavioural expectations.
- Groups will need to wear footwear and clothing suitable for an Outdoor Learning programme involving walks over parkland and woodland.
- Individuals will need to guard against the possibility of insect bites and allergic reactions; asthma, eczema etc.
- Groups will need to follow the programme as a group in order to ensure supervision at all times by a member of staff.
- Ratios for Key Stage 3 groups are 1:15 plus the visit leader
- A qualified First Aider (one-day emergency First Aid in schools or equivalent) will need to be present.
- Groups will also need to arrange for the point of contact to have a nominal roll and location contact details
- Please follow footpaths/mown areas wherever possible

Education Room

Uneven flooring please ensure suitable footwear is worn

The Ha-Ha

Take care to keep away from edges to prevent any falls into the Ha Ha

Interior Space

This is situated in a woodland area. Please keep together and respect wildlife, plants and shrubs.

Do not allow individuals to enter the space in order to avoid the risk of getting stuck Take care not to trip over protuberance at the front of the piece

Skyspace

Follow mown footpath to Skyspace gate Take care on entrance ramp- suitable footwear and adhering to code of conduct should ensure safety Take care in interior, especially in wet conditions- seating should be used. Keep to maximum group numbers

Go through gate to

St Elmo's Breath (Maximum number inside at any time 8)

Follow mown path across the field- beware of the molehills Refer to code of conduct/suitable footwear Please note maximum group numbers

Full Moon Circle

Beware of uneven ground There is a likelihood of deer/deer droppings Please ensure that the Circle is not stepped on The slate can have sharp edges Keep the group together and supervised as per initial brief
